Picture postcards documenting Walter Wellman and his airship flights to the North Pole and across the Atlantic.

First you catch the quail, then you cook it.
- 6 *Quartz* **Dalene Thomas**
Quartz and the various forms it can take.

- 8 - 17 *Swiss Fondue* **Bruce Marsden**
A synoptic overview of the philately of Switzerland.
- 18 - 24 *Swiss Army: Duties, Services and Patriotic Support, 1936-1945* **Ernest L. Bergman**
Demonstrating the very close relationship and support of the Swiss population with the army mail service, censorship, internee service, and postal administration.
- 25 - 32 *Swiss Airmail up to 1939* **George Struble**
Development of the Swiss airmail system from the 1913 pioneer flights, a unique chapter in airmail history, to the beginning of WWII in 1939.

- 33 - 34 *Campione d'Italia: A Geographic Anomaly* **Bruce Marsden**
 Surrounded by Switzerland and isolated from Italy in the later years of World War II, Campione issued its own stamps valid for mail to Switzerland and Liechtenstein.
- 35 - 42 *Switzerland's Stamp-Imprinted Envelopes: Federal Issues, 1867-86* **Harlan F. Stone**
 Essays, proofs, specimens, mint, used, errors, supplemental postage, destinations.
- 43 - 52 *The Usage of Switzerland's Imperforate Sitting Helvetia Issue of 1854-1863* **Steve P. Turchik**
 A world-class Strubel exhibit showing used individual and multiple items on and off covers, production, printing, and color varieties, bisects, destinations, and frankings.
- 53 - 58 *Landi: The 1939 Swiss National Exposition, A Tour via Contemporary Postcards* **Richard T. Hall**
 A tour of the buildings and attractions found at the 1939 Swiss National Exposition through the use of contemporary postcards.
- 59 *An Essay, Proofs and Specimens of Switzerland's Perforated Sitting Helvetia* **Harlan F. Stone**
 Trial combinations of papers, control mark, colors, perforations and cancellations.
- 60 - 69 *Swiss Stamp Booklets: 1907-1933* **James Johnstone**
 Main aspects of the production and use of definitive stamps made available in booklets in Switzerland from 1907 to 1933.
- 70 *SCADTA Mail from Switzerland* **George Struble**
 Swiss mail to be flown within Colombia by SCADTA (Sociedad Colombo Allemane de Transportes Aereos) using the required stamps issued by SCADTA.
- 71 *The World Headquarters of the International Refugee Organization at Geneva, 1947-1952* **Robert G. Zeigler**
 The story of the Geneva, Switzerland office of the short-lived UN agency responsible for post-WWII refugee resettlement, from overprinted stamps to elusive service covers.
- 72 - 77 *Swiss Flexible-Head Razor Cancelers Invented by Frederic de Coppet* **Roger Heath**
 Invention and development of flexible-head cancelers made by Frederic de Coppet for use by the Swiss Postal Administration.

- 78 *The Landi Europa Flights: April 29-May 28, 1939* **Richard T. Hall**
Covers from every city where a stop was made on the three European flights flown to publicize the 1939 Swiss National Exposition – the Landi.
- 79 - 83 *SCADTA Mail from and to Switzerland, 1923-1937* **Ian Gilchrist**
The development of mail services between Switzerland and Colombia and the issues of stamps by SCADTA to pay for their air mail services within Colombia.
- 84 *The Swiss Booklets That Never Were* **James Johnstone**
Preparation and use of two Swiss stamps, issued in 1921, which could have been used in booklets - but which never were.
- 85 - 89 *Apollo-Soyuz Test Project* **John Macco**
Crew selection and training, prelaunch tests, launch rendezvous and docking and finally the commemoration by many nations of the first joint space venture ever attempted.
- 90 *General Barry's Rocket Battalion, 1861-1863* **Robert Durst**
Development of General Barry's Rocket Battalion from its founding in New York, rocket testing in Washington DC, and deployment in the US Civil War, 1861-1862.
- 91 - 92 *Project Mercury: To Put a Man in Space* **Dennis Dillman**
Development of Project Mercury from rudimentary tests through all six successful manned space flights.
- 93 - 99 *The Wernher von Braun Rocket Team in War and Peace* **Robert Durst**
Wernher von Braun Rocket Team's experimental military rocket programs in Germany during WWII to 1961 at Cape Canaveral, Florida.
- 100 - 107 *"I Believe That This Nation...": The Story of How We Reached the Moon Six Times* **Ray E. Cartier**
US space program from Explorer 1 through the safe return of the last men to land on the moon.
- 108 *Onboard American Rocketplanes* **Dennis Dillman**
Covers flown onboard American rocket-powered aircraft from 1936 to the present.
- 109 - 111 *First Flight of the Space Shuttle: STS-1* **Pete Sarmiento**
First flight of the Space Shuttle STS-1 Orbiter "Columbia" through various covers canceled from NASA centers, DoD & NASA tracking stations, etc.

- 112 - 119 *Americans in Space: Projects Mercury, Gemini, and Apollo* **David S. Ball**
Efforts to put the first American in space through the first lunar landings and joint mission in orbit, told with event covers.
- 120 - 126 *Graf Zeppelin 127 Airmail* **Brian Callan**
- 127 *Philadelphia Carrier Adhesives and Handstamps, 1849-1863* **Larry Lyons**
Carrier adhesives and handstamps in use in Philadelphia 1849-1863, including regular issue stamps used to pay the carrier fee.
- 128 - 137 *Britain's Marvelous Machines* **Stephen McGill**
Review of the seven variety-driving factors of the series, 1967 to present.
- 138 - 145 *United States of Colombia* **Alfredo Frohlich**
Traditional presentation of the design, production and usage of the stamps issues of the period.
- 146 *The 1918 'Vassa' War Provisionals of Finland* **Robert W. Hisey**
Provisionals issued during the 'First War of Independence.'
- 147 - 156 *Newfoundland's Last Definitives: The Waterlow Printing* **Clarence A. Stillions**
Newfoundland's last definitives were produced by Waterlow & Sons as a consequence of WWII and continued until Newfoundland joined Canada in 1949.
- 157 - 164 *Hawaiian Postal History* **Richard Malmgren**
Hawaiian foreign postal history from the pre-postal period through the UPU period.
- 165 - 172 *Colombia: The 1917 Perkins Issue* **Santiago Cruz**
Essays and proofs to usages through multiples, varieties and errors.
- 173 - 182 *The U.S. 1948 Stone Stamp and Its First Day Covers* **Harlan F. Stone**
Stamp production, first day events, 67 Stone cachets, post-FDC usages.
- 183 - 192 *Baseball Centennial: Every Boy a Cover* **Jeff Bennett**
Traditional first day cover exhibit for the 1939 Baseball Centennial stamp.
- 193 - 200 *Civil Censorship in India, 1939-1945* **John Warren**
Indian civil censorship operations in four slightly overlapping time-based phases with an additional four part phase to accommodate special markings and labels.

- 201 - 210 *The 2 Cent Jackson Regular Issue, 1870-1879* **Matthew W. Kewriga**
Essays, proofs, issued stamps including multiples, cancellations,
domestic and international mails.
- 211 - 218 *The Hong Kong 'China' Overprints on Stamps and Stationery* **Ian C. Gibson-Smith**
British Post Offices in China from 1917 to 1930.
- 219 - 227 *Tunisia, 1888-1942* **Norval Rasmussen**
Stamps and the use of the stamps from this time period.
- 228 - 235 *America's Library: The Library of Congress* **Larry T. Nix**
Story of the Library of Congress and how it used the mail to carry out
its mission.
- 236 - 242 *Puerto Rico: Pre-stamp Inland Postal Routes* **Frank J. Acevedo**
Covers from every town in three postal routes as prescribed by the
Spanish Royal Decree of 1811.
- 243 - 244 *The New Zealand Half-Penny Mt. Cook Issues, 1898-1908* **George W. Bowman**
Printings, perf and shade varieties, officials, some re-entries, postal
stationery and usages.
- 245 - 248 *Machine Vended Postage Labels of Germany, 1981-2008* **Deepak Haritwal**
All designs of machine vended (ATM) postage labels for Germany
from 1981 to 2008.
- 249 - 252 *1930s Nationalism in the Postmarks of Japan* **Donald G. Vorhis**
The 1934 change of country name and the 1938 change of
romanization system.
